For the intent issue in **BATTERY**

MISS

The parties argued, and the defendant grabbed the plaintiff's arm. The defendant had intent for battery.

HIT

By grabbing the plaintiff's arm during an argument, the defendant acted with intent to cause harmful or offensive contact, and that meets the intent element for battery.

For the breach issue in **NEGLIGENCE**

MISS

The driver is liable because he was speeding.

HIT

The driver's excessive speed shows a failure to use reasonable care.

For the formation issue in **CONTRACTS**

MISS

The seller sent an email offering to sell the bike. The buyer accepted. A contract was formed.

HIT

The seller's email expressed a present intent to be bound, and the buyer's acceptance completed their mutual assent, forming a contract.

For the consideration issue in
CONTRACTS

MISS

The employer promised a bonus, and the employee accepted, so there was consideration.

BETTER

The employee's continued work in reliance on the promised bonus supplied new legal value, creating sufficient consideration for the agreement.

For personal jurisdiction in **CIV** **PRO**

MISS

The company sold goods online, so the court had jurisdiction.

BETTER

By targeting advertisements and shipping several orders to the forum state, the defendant purposefully availed herself of that forum's market, satisfying minimum contacts.
